

## Epic new \$2.2bn NFL stadium passes major construction milestone as amazed fans compare it to Rome Colosseum

A STUNNING new \$2.2bn NFL stadium has crossed off an important construction milestone, and fans have praised the progress.

The stadium is set to open for the 2027 [NFL](#) season.

The [Tennessee Titans](#) revealed that their future home, New Nissan Stadium, has reached a major construction achievement.

[New Nissan Stadium](#), located in Nashville, Tennessee, is 75 percent complete as the Daktronics LED board is taking shape and will “be an integral part of the stadium’s fan experience,” per the team.

The milestone was complete in late March.

The Titans posted pictures of the new Nissan Stadium – both inside and outside the venue.

Construction is, of course, still underway, as workers were seen working on the masonry facade along the exterior base of the site.

As for the inside of the stadium, the concrete masonry units – precast rectangular blocks – are nearly finished as more than 50,000 of the 52,000 square feet are finished.

Fans were impressed with the stadium’s progress on social media.

“Amazing pictures on every slide!! I’m in tears. Great start to a new regime, baby! Titanup!!” one wrote on Instagram.

“Picture 5 makes this feel like a Colosseum from Rome, and I love it. The interior of our stadium has a lot of character,” one fan commented about a picture from the stadium’s tunnel view of an eventual field.

“Well done,” a third added.

Ground broke on the New Nissan Stadium two years ago.

It will cost \$2.2bn to build the 60,000-plus seat stadium. The Titans have played at Nissan Stadium since 1999.
